Hurricane Ida Relief

To date Meadowbrook, together with the Briarwood Church of Christ in Natchez, has collected a total of \$13,375 toward Hurricane Ida relief efforts. A portion of these funds was used to purchase items that the Church of Christ Disaster Response Team (CoCDRT) needed immediately for the effort in Jean Lafitte, LA. Laundry detergent, dryer sheets, Gatorade, and lawn rakes were purchased in large quantities and shipped directly to Jean Lafitte. The church there has been doing laundry for all first responders as well as community residents. The remainder of funds will be sent to the CoCDRT home office in Tipp City, Ohio, for purchase of larger items, such as sheet rock, insulation, etc.

Items collected by our members and Meadowbrook Preschool are on hold in FC2 for delivery in a couple of weeks to the churches in Jean Lafitte or Houma, LA. Rebuilding efforts in Houma have been much slower and storage area has not been available. We also partnered with Van Waites from the Lake Harbour Church of Christ to purchase over 300 lbs. of meat to feed 3,000-4,000 people in Golden Meadow, LA. [See video here.](#)

Meadowbrook contacted area churches to partner with us in this relief effort. Several responded positively and while most were already involved in various aspects of hurricane relief, they indicated interest in future cooperative efforts.
