**Mission Trip** From May 10-19, Musa and Brad Blake will be traveling to the village of Dono-Manga in Chad to visit long-time friend, Pierre Rimorbe, who Brad taught at seminary in northern Nigeria. By God's grace, Pierre has led a church-planting movement in Dono-Manga. In 2007, Brad and Jen created a non-profit eventually named Hope Springs International to assist with their northern Nigerian humanitarian projects. As a result of local famine and disease in Chad in 2009, Pierre reached out to Hope Springs for assistance. Through Hope Springs, over the past decade a clinic, orphanage, primary school, and secondary school have been developed impacting tens of thousands. At Pierre's request, Musa and Brad are traveling with a group from Hope Springs to work in the clinic distributing medicines, a soccer camp in the orphanage, and English instruction in the schools. One way the Meadowbrook family may assist with this effort is to fill a couple of suitcases with the following medical supplies: **1) Battery-operated blood pressure machines; 2) Bathroom scales; 3) Extra batteries for machines and scales; 4) Stethoscopes; 5) Celsius thermometers; 6) Large-size rubber gloves.** The Blakes are also receiving financial donations through the Meadowbrook church for the expenses of the mission for airline tickets, visas, immunizations, ground transport, and travel incidentals.
