We are planning on a drive-by drop-off groceries event, to take place on Sunday, August 2, from 2:00 to 4:00 p.m. This will be the only collection. You drive up through the Druid Hills parking lot; stop under the awning between the auditorium and the education building; pop your trunk; the teens will unload your groceries and carry them into the church foyer; you exit by the Barrington. That's it! You never have to get out of your car!
