## Update on Disaster Relief Assistance

Meadowbrook has continued their partnership with the Churches of Christ Disaster Response Team (DRT) out of Tipp City, OH. DRT has worked with the Enterprise Blvd Church of Christ following Hurricane Laura and continued after Hurricane Delta. They have tarped roofs, put on roofs, cleaned up yards, torn out drywall, and installed insulation and drywall. They also cooked for the community on several occasions.

In a thank-you letter received from DRT they stated, "Please know that the good stewardship of all donations is of high importance, and donations are put to thoughtful and prayerful use to help the survivors of disasters." Full content of their letter is attached in this morning's email.

Monetary donations collected to date from Meadowbrook members and the Briarwood Church of Christ in Natchez total **\$7,925**. Meadowbrook will continue to receive donations to assist with disaster relief through the end of December and additional monies will be sent to DRT as they are received.
