Meadowbrook is preparing for its annual blood drive to ensure that Meadowbrook families are covered under the Mississippi Blood Services insurance policy. The policy gives you credit for blood and blood products that you or your immediate family may need in the future. The policy is good for one year. Meadowbrook needs at least 20 blood donors to continue our coverage. Donors must be at least 16 years old, weigh 110 lbs., and be in good health (16 & 17 year olds must have written parental consent).
